Hitkarini Children's Academy, Jonesganj, Jabalpur was established on 1st July 1997. Then Secretary of the primary section *Shri Anand Mohan Pathak ji* took initiative to start this English medium school under the guidance of *Smt. Ratna Kumari Devi ji*, then President of Hitkarini Sabha with strength of 35 students'. The fees structure of the school was rupees 50/- per month. Today the school is leading towards new

directions with strength of 504 students from Nursery to 12th with a staff of 20 Teachers.
