About School

The esteemed organization, Kasturchand Hitkarini Sabha, situated within Jabalpur, a locale through which courses the sacred river Narmada and native land of Saint Jabali, on 27th March 1871 approved the establishment of a school, in General meeting of Kasturchand Hitkarini Sabha. An action plan was proposed for the development of the Multidimensional Higher Secondary School, which commenced its operations with 6 students and was named as Indian School. In a meeting of the Hitkarini Sabha on 21st March 1903, the name was changed to Kasturchand Hitkarini School.

The dignified members of Hitkarini Sabha have given their contribution in guiding the literary, cultural, administration and all round development of educational values of the school.

Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose, Former President Dr. Radha Krishnan, Former Governor Parrabhisitarmaya renowned actor Prithviraj Kapoor, Poet Suryakant Tripathi 'Nirala', Mahadevi Verma, Ramdhari Singh 'Dinkar' have privileged and glorified the institution time to time by their presence as Chief Guests. Pandit Ravi Shankar Shukla has added glory to our organization by serving his duties as a teacher. Incredible students of our school are imparting their knowledge in different social, political, academic and cultural areas.

In the succession of principals, Shri Vipin Kumar Bose, Shri Chandrabhan Mukherjee, Shri Vipin Bihari Das, Shri Kalicharan Bose, Rai Bahadur Raghuvar Prasad Dwivedi, Shri Surendra Nath Bose, Shri Kishori Lal Pandey, Shri Mohan Lal Agrawal, Shri Avdhesh Prasad Gautam, Shri Harnarayan Tiwari, Shri Bhagwat Prasad Awasthi, Shri S.S. Mishra, Shri S.P. Pandey, Shri Shivdutt Bajpai, Shri Balram Shukla were the eminent personalities.

In response to the demand for an English Medium School, Sabha officials made a significant decision to convert Kasturchand Hitkarini Higher Secondary School into English Medium.

Thanks to the influential efforts of one of the prominent member of Sabha, Shri Anand Mohan Pathak Ji, the then Secretary of the Primary section, on July 1st, 1997 Hitkarini Children Academy was established under the guidance of Smt. Ratna Kumari Devi Ji, then President of Hitkarini Sabha with a strength of 35 students. At that time the fee structure of the school was Rs.50/- per month. But now by good fortune the strength has reached upto 413 students. Right now we are running Nursery to class XII successfully. At present, Mrs. Archana Gupta is working on the post of Principal. It is a self financed school.

Cultural And Sports Activities
